This funding will be used to

- Increase year level data in the achievement of English:
 - Improving English A-B from 39% in 2021 to 50% in 2022.
 - Improving English A-C from 79% in 2021 to 85% in 2022.
- Invest in the capability and development of our teaching team (Highly Skilled Workforce and Successful Learners)

Our initiatives include

- Purchase full time HOD-C as per the LCC process.
- Whole school engagement and collaboration in Leading Learning Collaborative with Dr Lyn Sharratt
- Quality assure curriculum and pedagogical practices in English with a particular focus on the Science of Reading via the Department of Education Reading Centre. Investing in 2 days a term for each teaching team to work collaboratively with our HOD-C.
- Maintain non-teaching workforce allocation.
- Build staff capability through targeted professional learning in English:
 - The Science of Reading
 - Assessment processes and tracking student achievement
 - Continued clarity around Australian Curriculum implementation
 - Sustain a culture of self-evaluation and reflection of teaching practices
- Continued implementation of our Dr Lyn Sharratt school improvement focus:
 - Case management (#6)
 - Learning Walks (#14, #4)
 - Early and ongoing intervention (#5)
 - Quality assessment informs instruction (#3)

| • Purchase additional Teacher Aide staff to support student outcomes in English | (\$99 000) |
| • Purchase release time and resourcing to support school improvement via Dr Lyn Sharratt | (\$900) |
| • Purchase TRS to facilitate team planning sessions each term | |
| ◦ Year level Australian Curriculum unit planning between Weeks 7-10 | (\$52 000) |
| ◦ Reading specific term planning between Weeks 1-2 | (\$52 000) |
